- 1) <u>Purpose</u>. This document captures the minutes of the Executive Board (EB) Meeting held via Zoom on the subject date. All times listed are Eastern U.S.
- 2) <u>Call to Order and Roll Call</u>. President Kevin Pryor called the meeting to order at 8:02 PM. Executive Director Ranae Bartlett recorded the Open Sessions of the meeting using Zoom.
