

## K-12 GRADE CHAMPS, PT. 2

This week, we return to the K-12 Grade Championships from last month in Orlando. We see a number of mating nets and remove-the-
guard exercises this week, so let's see one nice position where these two themes converge in a dangerous opening trap from the deadly Najdorf Sicilian.
In our example, Black fell into a deep opening trap with their last move (10. ... h6). Now, White wins with 11. Ne6! trapping the queen, since 11. ... Bxd5 (or 11. ... fxe6 12. Qh5+ g6 13. Qxg6 is mate; as a bonus, if Black tries 11. ... Qa5, how should White respond?) 12. Nxd8
hxg5 13. Qxd5 Rxd8 nets only two pieces for the queen. Nice, right?




## SOLUTIONS

1) Again, we kick things off with two forced mates. 33. Qg8+ Here, Black resigned, rather than face 33. ... Rxg8 34. Nxf7 mate. (Hyatt - Baalla, Orlando, 2023) 2) A nice "clearance" sacrifice: 21. Ne7+ Nxe7 Note that 21. ... Rxe7 makes no difference: 22. Bh7+ Kh8 23. Bg6+ Kg8 24. Qh7+ Kf8 25. Qh8 mate. 22. Bh7+ Kh8 23. Bg6+ when Black resigned due to 23. ... Kg8 24. Qh7+ Kf8 25. Qxf7 mate. (Liu - Vemparala, Orlando, 2023) 3) 26.
f5 Cutting off the queen's defenses with tempo! After 26. ... Qa6 27. Qxg4 Kh8 Or 27. ... Qxa2 28. Bxh6 winning. 28. Qf3 Qxa2 29. Qd1, White was up a clean piece and won shortly. (Katta - Xin, Orlando, 2023) 4) 17. Bxh7+ Kxh7 18. Qh5+ Here, Black resigned, due to 18. ... Kg8 19. Qg5 g6 20. Qh6, with mate to follow. Black's queen has a few spite checks, but nothing more. (Casares Contreras - Hua, Orlando, 2023) 5) 27. Nb5! Lovely interference! The
b-pawn has broken through! (Lu Scanlon, Orlando, 2023) 6) 40. b6! If 40. a5, then 40. ... Bc5! 41. b6 and Black meets b6-b7 with ... Bc5-a7. 40. ... Ke7 Not 40. ... Bc5, when 41. b7 Ba7 42. b4 is winning. 41. a5 Kd7 42. a6 Kc6 43. a7 Kb7 44. Bd5+ when White is winning. (Ayyappan - Wu, Orlando, 2023) BONUS) Simplest is 12. Ndc7+, when Black's only legal move is 12. ... Qxc7 and then 13.
Nxc7+ Kd8 14. Nxa8 is materially crushing. (Wang - Ji, Orlando, 2023)
