



ST. LOUIS RAPID & BLITZ, PT. 1

This week features tactics from last month's **Saint Louis Rapid & Blitz**, where GM Levon Aronian took clear first ahead of Olympiad teammates GMs Fabiano Caruana and Wesley So. Enjoy some time scramble tricks!

In our **example**, Black had been hoping for a draw despite the bad bishop. This looks tenuous after Nf7xe5, but stranger things have happened in time scrambles. Then, White uncorked **51. Kg2!** and Black resigned. Why? Well, it's mate once White's knight gets to either the f5- or g6-square. Black's bishop was powerless against the knight's many

routes along different diagonals in Dominguez – Shankland.





SOLUTIONS

1) 36. Rh3 Black had resigned two moves prior, anticipating this queen trap. (So – Oparin, St. Louis, 2025)
2) 31. Qxf6 Other moves might win. But they don't get style points. 31. ... gxf6 Oparin allowed this mate to be played out, which is classy!
32. Bxf6 mate. (Gukesh – Oparin, St. Louis, 2025) 3) 49. ... Rg2+ Winning the knight. 50. Kf5 Even worse would be 50. Kh5 Be2 mate.
50. ... Bd3+ The g6-knight falls, and

Black's king can reach safety on the h7-square. (Vachier-Lagrave – Le, St. Louis, 2025). 4) 57. Bc8+ An easy move to miss in time trouble! White played 57. Rc8?? and after 57. ... g2, resigned just five moves later. 57. ... Kf4 Black's only legal move, which should tell you what's coming. 58. Rf6+ The only defense is ... Be4-f5, when either capture from White wins. (Caruana – Le, St. Louis, 2025, analysis) 5) 23. Rxe6+ fxe6 24. Qxe6+ Re7 Or 24. ... Kf8 25. Qxf6+

Kg8 26. Rd8+ still wins the h8-rook.

25. Qc8+ Kf7 26. Qxh8 There is no perpetual, as White shows. 26. ...

Qe3+ 27. Rd2 The knight is poisoned, due to Qh8-h7+ with mating threats.

(Shankland – Gukesh, St. Louis, 2025) 6) 38. Nd4 White removes the guard while and threatens Nd4-c6+.

38. ... Nf1+ If 38. ... Rxf4 39. Nc6+ and White is piece-up. 39. Kg2 Rxf4 Black's rook is still overloaded! 40.

Nc6+ and Black resigned soon.
