


Delegate Length of Service

Responsibilities

Governance is a shared responsibility

Delegates	Executive Board
Legislative Body	Provide Leadership Continuity and Management Oversight
Steward/Amend Rules of Chess	Appoint Executive Director, Evaluate Progress
Control Physical Assets (i.e. building)	Set Strategic Direction
Appoint: Audit, Bylaws, Election, Ethics and Nominating (6 of 8 members) Committees	Appoint and Oversee Committees
Approves Budget	Serve As Complaint Appellate Body



Responsibilities

- Delegates and Board are US Chess Fiduciaries
- Key Concepts

Fiduciary Duty	Definition
Duty of Loyalty	 No Personal Gain Disclosure of Conflicts of Interest Information is privileged & confidential
Duty of Care	Act in Good FaithAct in Best Interest of Organization



Finance and Investments

- US Chess posts quarterly financials
 - Annual audited financials too
 - Annual 990 tax filings
- Investments managed by committees
 - Finance Workshop will provide details





Participating in Meeting

- Delegates Call is Your Guide
 - Agenda
 - Proposals
 - Names of other Delegates
- Quorum = 1/3 delegates present
- Mics set up in Front & Back
 - Front = For
 - Back = Against
- Robert's Rules of Order Used



Voting in Meeting

To vote: Raise Credentials



Action	Voting Requirement
Vote on Regular Motion	Simple Majority
Amend Bylaws	On Advance Agenda, Simple Majority Not On Advance Agenda, 2/3 Majority
Amend Official Rules of Chess	2/3 Majority at 2 Consecutive Delegate Meetings; or 2-Year requirement can be overridden with 85% approval
