US Chess represents the United States in the World Chess Federation (FIDE), connecting our members to chess players around the world. Founded in 1939 with the merger of the American Chess Federation and the National Chess Federation, US Chess has grown to serve more than 116,000 members and 1,300 affiliated chess clubs and organizations today. Every year, US Chess sanctions and rates more than 17,000 tournaments and 1.2 million games. We host more than 25 national championships and award titles to amateurs and professionals ranging from elementary school students to senior citizens.

SUBMITTING YOUR AD

PREFERRED FILE FORMAT: PRESS-READY PDF

To ensure the highest quality print, please follow these guidelines when submitting your ad.

Preferred File Format

- **Press-Ready PDF** (preferred)
- Alternative Formats: **JPEG, EPS, or PSD** (if necessary)

Text:

- Preferred: **Outlined text** (to ensure consistent appearance)
- Acceptable: **Embedded text** (if outlining is not possible)

Deadlines

- Ad files must be submitted at least **two months prior to the publication date**.

Design & Formatting Requirements

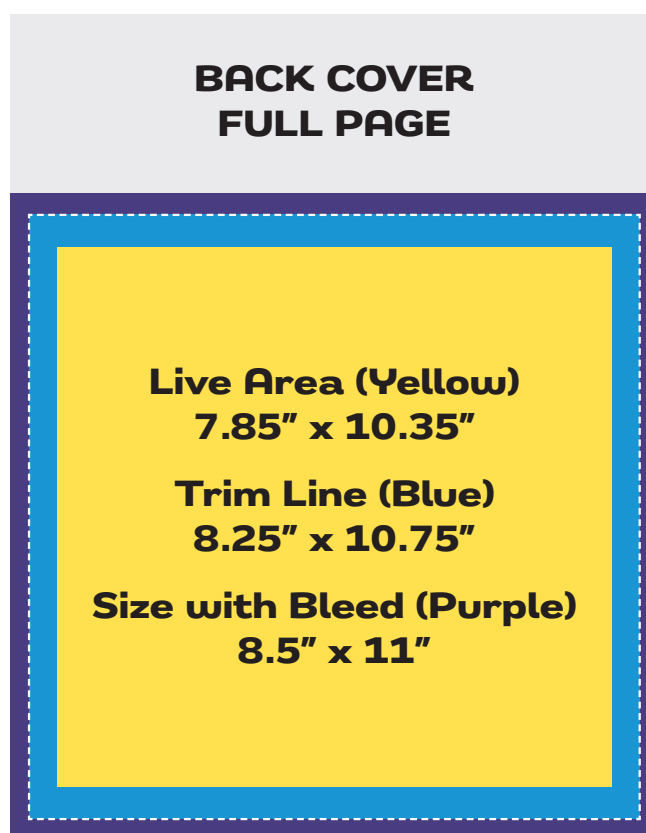
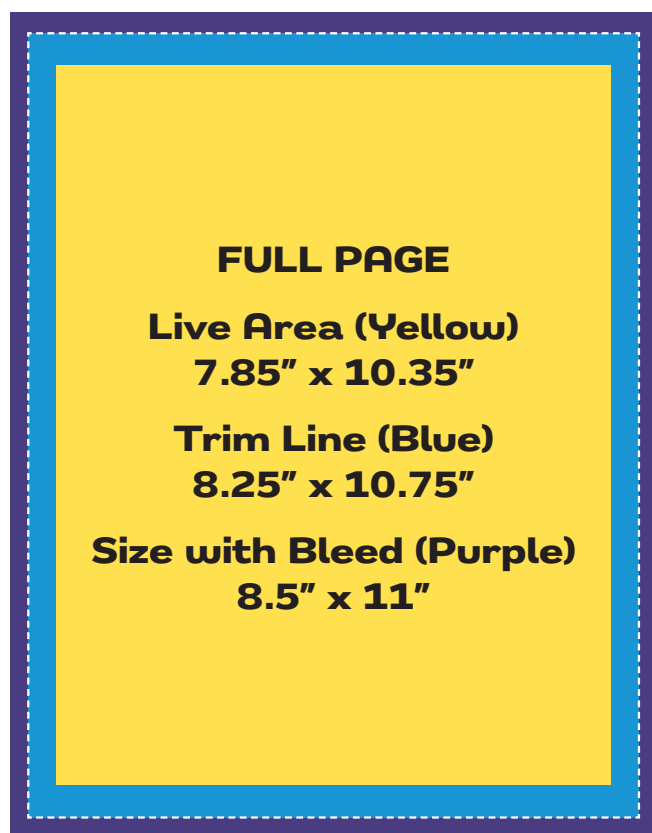
- Resolution: **300 DPI** recommended (150 DPI minimum)
- Color Mode: **CMYK** only (no RGB)
- Transparency: **Flatten all transparency** to avoid unexpected print issues.
- Bleed: **1/8 inch** (0.125") when extending to the edge of the page (full-page ads)
- Margin: **1/8 inch** (0.125") from the edge for important content

1/2 page (H)	7" X 4 1/2" (4.5")

PLEASE NOTE FOR FULL PAGE ADS:

When a printer trims pages, a small amount of shifting occurs. The Bleed and Margin ensure optimal trimming results by accounting for this. All elements meant to extend to the page edge should be extended beyond the edge to create a Bleed, which is represented by the purple box. Important elements should not be placed outside of the Margin, which is represented by the yellow box, to ensure they will not be trimmed off.
